Dear partners,

We would like to call your attention to the following important points and to ask you to forward this important information to all your students selected to come to the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Granada and the Coordinator /staff involved in this process:

1. Please find an **attachment** with **relevant information** necessary for the preparation of the Learning Agreement for the 2014-2015 academic year at the Faculty of Medicine (University of Granada): an [Info Sheet](#) with relevant information concerning the **online application**, the **deadlines** at the University of Granada, the **procedure for Medical Students**, and other important information.

2. For academic and organizational reasons, we kindly ask to all our partners to **respect the bilateral agreement** signed regarding not only the number of students exchanged but also the **length of stay** which is for less than one academic year. This means that the bilateral agreement has been signed for receiving students who are coming to do a **clinical training, and not subjects** (theoretical and practice parts).

**3. The Faculty of Medicine of the University of Granada does NOT ACCEPT ANY STUDENT FOR A DIFFERENT LENGTH OF STAY THAN THE ONE AGREED. To share the total number of months between several students is not possible either.**

4. If the student selects more than one medical specialty, he or she has to stay for **at least one month in each one.**

The specialties offered are: **General Surgery, Internal Medicine, Cardiology, Otorhinolaryngology, A & E.**

5. Incoming students can not start their practice before the end of September. They have to know that they would start the practice at least one week after their arrival.

6. Although a certificate of Spanish level is not required, we highly recommend at least a B1 level.
