Please, note that our deadlines for online application might change:

Deadline for online application (whole-year and first-semester incoming students): from 01/04/2021 until 15/05/2021 ([link](#)).

Deadline for online application (second-semester incoming students): from 01/10/2021 until 31/10/2021 ([link](#)).

If you have not nominated your students yet, please send your nominations to our Mobility Office as your earliest convenience (email: medori@ugr.es).

Concerning the Learning Agreement, your students have to follow the steps explained at: “Pasos a seguir”

We kindly remind you that the subjects have a theoretical and a practical part. However, **to do only the practical part of one subject will not be possible**. Students have to course the **whole subject** included on their Learning Agreement. They also have to do the exam of the whole subject.

Given that our subjects are evaluated with a single final mark (which takes into account student achievements in theoretical and practical competences). **Clinical practice certificates (or any other kind of certification apart from the final subject mark) will not be delivered.**
